Itinerary



Day 1

Arrival

- Travel to Bali. Transfer to Lombok via Speed Boat.
- Settle in at your accommodation in a local village followed by briefing and welcome dinner.

Day 2

Community Engagement

- After breakfast, trek to the waterfall, rice fields and coffee garden
- Environmental and strategic planning followed by staggered lunch at RDA restaurant
- Meet local school kids and start teaching using games and art and craft.

Day 3

Sembalun Crater Rim

- The day is full of adventure. The group will travel to Sambalun after breakfast.
- Start trek and camp on Crater Rim

Day 4

Day 2 at the Summit

- After spending the night star gazing and enjoying the beauty of Sembalum, the group will start their trek at dawn to the summit.
- Breakfast at Summit. Time in relax and marvel the beauty around.
- Return back to the Senaru village

Day 5

Senaru to Geli Meno

- Breakfast at the village. It's time to say goodbye to your host families, villagers, guides and potters.
- Arrive at Gili Meno. Take some well deserved rest on the beaches and spend time exploring the island and snorkeling
- Presentation and goodbye dinner.
